

Raffle Ticket Instructions

Terra Schools is asking each family to sell raffle tickets as part of our annual Lunar New Year Festival fundraiser. The festival takes place Saturday, February 5th, 2022. Tickets sales run from now until Tuesday, Feb 1st. 2022

HOW THE RAFFLE WORKS:

- 1. Each student takes home 10 books of tickets (each book contains 5 tickets). There are more books available at Front Desk if you can sell more.
- 2. Students sell tickets to friends, neighbors, family, and anyone who wants to support Terra Schools and win a prize. A single ticket costs \$10; a book of five tickets costs \$40. Remember to keep the ticket stub and collect the money. Give the buyers the portion of the ticket that lists the prizes.
- 3. By Tuesday, Feb 1st, 2022: Turn in all ticket stubs, money, and unsold tickets to your classroom teacher. Ticket stubs will not be accepted without accompanying cash or check. Write the student's name and grade on the SELLER INFOR at the return portion. Place the money and the top portion of the raffle ticket in an envelope and return to teacher. Teachers, please deliver your class's envelopes with ticket stubs and unsold tickets to the front desk, so we can keep selling raffle tickets during the event.
- 4. Saturday, Feb 5th,2022: All the raffle prize drawings will take place during the Lunar New Year Festival. Winners do not need to be present to win. We will contact winners after the event.

<u>TIPS:</u> Carry your raffle tickets wherever you go. Sell to family, friends or co-workers. If you think you might sell more than 10 books of tickets, don't hesitate to ask the front desk or your teacher for more ticket books. You can always return any unsold tickets to the school by <u>Tuesday, February 1st, 2022.</u>

Parents: Remember that selling tickets is a great opportunity for your children to build confidence, interact with people, and practice accounting for tickets and money. Selling tickets gives your child a way to feel proud of supporting our school.
